Adjusted level 1 regulations

- Top Left: CURFEW:** Alert Level 1. Curfew is from midnight to 4AM. Apart from permitted workers, no person may be outside their place of residence during curfew.

- Bottom Left: GATHERINGS:** Alert Level 1. Gatherings are permitted. Indoor gatherings may not exceed 50 persons or capacity of 75% maximum of 100 people. Outdoor gatherings may not exceed 100 people. Health precautions must be observed at all times, and a distance of at least 1.5 metres between people.
- Bottom Right: MANDATORY MASK WEARING:** Alert Level 1. Wearing a cloth mask or similar covering over the nose and mouth is mandatory when in public. Any person who does not wear a mask in a public place will be committing an offence.
