Membership Fee Increase

At its meeting of 13th November 2020, The UASA National Executive Committee (NEC) had the unenviable task of evaluating the proposed budget of the Union, for the forthcoming financial year, in order to ensure its continued efficient operations, high levels of service and the provision of benefits, whilst been mindful of the uncertain economic climate and growth challenges faced due to the COVID 19 pandemic and lockdown.

After much deliberation, it was decided to adjust membership fees by around 3%, resulting in a modest increase of R4 for active members, from R128 to R132 per member/ month and for other types of membership i.e. Pensioner/ Golden Year/ Widow/ Widower, a modest increase of R3, from R105 to R108 per member/ month, with effect from February 2021.
